World-renowned fashion photographer and former apprentice bowmaker Juergen Teller reveals yet another string this month with *Märchenstüberl* at London's Modern Art gallery. The show (which roughly translates as 'fairytale room') collects Teller's more personal work aside from his famous editorial and advertising work, offering to provide a veritable Bavarian grotto of visual delights, while downstairs a movie of his *Go-Sees* project will be screened. For two days (November 10-11), Teller's images will also appear as a billboard installation on the advertising hoardings above Old Street roundabout. The show precedes solo exhibition at New York's Lehmann Maupin in 2002.
